

Diary Notes

1. Services follow the normal pattern for February. This means that the Family Communion at Hallow moves to 4th February as we will be inviting Hallow School to celebrate Education Sunday.
2. Ash Wednesday falls this year on 14th February. As before there will be two opportunities to mark this important day. There will be services therefore at Hallow at 10am and Holt at 7:30pm. Both services will include the Imposition of Ashes.
3. Last year there was a rather disappointing take up with the Lent Course. Alongside this there are some practical issues relating to changes of dates and times as well as space issues. Consequently there will not be an organised Benefice Lent Course this year. However the Monday Morning Housegroup is going to use the latest York Course study "On the Third Day".
