On behalf of Holt Parish Council I would like to welcome you to the village of Holt Heath. We hope your move went well.

The purpose of this letter is to give you a little information about the village of Holt Heath. Also enclosed is a list of telephone numbers for local amenities, which we hope you will find useful. We also have a village website at www.holtworcester.com. This contains information about the village, local services and events.

The parish of Holt has a population of approximately 600. The village facilities include the Post Office and village shop, two Public Houses, Village Hall and two Farm Shops. In addition there are recreational facilities on the Millennium Green. The village shares a primary and pre school with the neighbouring village of Grimley and the local comprehensive is in the nearby village of Martley.

There are a number of historical buildings within the village including the Holt Fleet and Red Lion Public Houses and the Holt Mill. The Church of St Martin is a mid 12th Century Grade 1 listed building. It is located three quarters of a mile east of the village centre opposite Holt Castle, which is also a Grade 1 listed building. The Holt Fleet Bridge was designed by Thomas Telford and opened in 1828.
